Committee members reviewed each of the criterion and reached a consensus as to whether the application addressed the criteria. A consensus report was prepared.

A charter school application from the Community Public Charter School in Charlottesville was distributed to members. The committee will discuss this application at its next meeting on June 21, 2005. The meeting will be held at the Department of Education at 10 a.m. in the 23<sup>rd</sup> floor north conference room.

Members inquired if there was an exemplary charter school application from a school located in the United States that could be shared with the committee. Mrs. Saslaw has one from a school in Washington, D.C. that will be shared with members.
