## **STI INDIVIDUAL Pamphlet Project**

**Topic:** *STI's (Sexually Transmitted Infections)*. From the list below, you will choose one STI to research and gather information on to create a pamphlet. You are required to submit a note sheet on the information you gathered along with the pamphlet you created; both are worth a grade! You may use notebook paper, printer paper, etc. for the note sheet. To research this information, you will sign-out a laptop from the laptop cart. This is considered a project and will be worth two summative grades. This project will be due at the end of NEXT class period. Please be sure to use your time wisely, as you are being given adequate time to complete. If you do not complete this project in class, you must complete it on your own time. There will be 5 points deducted PER DAY (with exception of the weekend) for late work.

### **STI's (Choose 1):**

- HIV/AIDS
- Pubic Lice
- Scabies
- Trichomoniasis
- Hepatitis B & C
- Chlamydia
- Genital Herpes
- Gonorrhea
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) (Genital Warts)
- Syphilis

**Required Information:** The following information must be included in your pamphlet.

- Your first and last name\*
- STI name
- STI definition
- Type of STI
  - Bacterial, parasitic, or viral
- Transmission of STI
  - What are ways somebody can contract this STI?
- Long-Term effects/complications of STI
- Signs & symptoms of STI
- Statistics about STI
- Treatment
  - Is this STI treatable?
  - Is this STI curable?
  - How is this STI treatable and/or curable?
- Prevention
  - How do you reduce your risks of contracting this STI?
- Sources of information
- Separate note sheet of information gathered

**Resources:** Make sure you are keeping track of where you get your information. It is a requirement to list your sources on the back side of the pamphlet. You must use at least three different sources in your pamphlet.
