Program Update

- Virtual Virginia offered **72** courses in the 2016-17 school year.
- All VVa core courses meet or exceed Virginia's Standards of Learning.
- All VVa Advanced Placement courses are audited and approved by the College Board as well as the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA).
- All VVa teachers are highly qualified and endorsed.



2016-17 Enrollment

- **6250** Enrollments to begin 2016-17
 - Full-Time program
 - Supplemental program
- Record enrollment

Supplemental Program

- Currently, there are **4308** students enrolled in **5268** courses.
- **1.22** enrollments per student

Full-Time Program

- Currently, there are **109** students enrolled in **632** courses.
- **5.8** courses per enrollment.
- Most common reasons for withdrawal are:
 - Back to Homeschool
 - Schedule change
 - Difficulty/Inactivity

Local EPF

- **5519** enrollments
- **44** schools
- **95** local teachers
- Divisions are also using the course on their own learning management system.

Math Outreach

- Algebra I
- Geometry
- **25** Schools
- **36** Classrooms
- Most schools and teachers have differing plans on how to use Outreach resources.
