SUBJECT: USDA Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program School Selection for 2010-2011 and WebEx Orientation, July 29, 2010

This memo notifies school divisions of final selection of elementary schools funded to participate in the USDA Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) for the school year 2010-2011. The list of schools that will receive funding is Attachment A to this memo. A total of 120 elementary schools applied; Virginia's allocation of \$2.48 million was adequate to fund 89 schools at approximately \$66 per student in enrollment. Nearly 50% more schools will receive funding in 2010-2011 as compared to 2009-2010. The FFVP funding allocation will continue to increase annually which will permit ongoing increases in the number of schools receiving FFVP funding. If your school(s) were not funded this year, we encourage you to reapply in the future.

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) used established criteria issued in Superintendent's Memorandum #130-10 to determine the schools that will receive FFVP funding in 2010-2011. Funding was allocated based on individual school enrollment as a percentage of the total enrollment of the selected schools. Each selected school will receive an allocation for the first quarter, **July 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010**, and an allocation for the second through fourth quarters, **October 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011**. Individual school funding allocations will be transmitted via a letter to the division superintendent along with a request to submit the FFVP addendum to the annual agreement in order to indicate acceptance of the funding and intent to participate in the FFVP. The *Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program Addendum to the Annual Agreement to Participate* is Attachment B to this memo; the addendum will also be mailed to the superintendent with the school selection letter.

The school nutrition program director/supervisor and appropriate FFVP school team members are invited to participate in FFVP orientation via WebEx on **Thursday, July 29, 2010** from 9 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. Information regarding WebEx registration will be sent via e-mail to the school nutrition program contact person. At least one person from each participating school division should participate in the orientation. Topics to be covered include:

- Fresh fruit and vegetable program creditable foods;
- Nutrition education;
- FFVP operational issues;
- Sharing ideas for successful implementation; and
- Compliance monitoring by VDOE-SNP.

A separate session on financial reporting, claim submission and budget monitoring will be conducted via WebEx in August. Additional information about that session will also be sent via e-mail to the SNP contact person of each participating school division. **Addendum to State Agency – School Food Authority Annual Agreement to Participate
Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program**

This agreement is between the Virginia Department of Education and the _____ County/City Public Schools (School Food Authority) and covers the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.

The undersigned has the authority to enter into this Agreement to participate in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (Program) as authorized by Section 19 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act, amended by Public Law 110-234.

A. It is mutually agreed between the State Agency and School Food Authority that:

1. The School Food Authority agrees that the funds will only be used for the purposes authorized by Section 19 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act, as amended.
2. The School Food Authority agrees to abide by all of the requirements for administering the Program as stated in Section 19 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act, as amended.
3. The School Food Authority agrees to provide funds to the approved school(s) under its jurisdiction for the service of approved fresh fruits and vegetables in accordance with local, State, and Federal regulations and requirements.
4. The School Food Authority agrees that the schools approved will implement the program in accordance with the plan outlined in the signed school application for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program.

B. General Conditions

1. This Agreement is non-transferable.
2. Neither the State Agency nor the School Food Authority has an obligation to renew this agreement.
